



COMBINED CYCLE POWER PLANT ERBIL

IRAQ

In July 2012, Mass Group Holding has started converting its 1.000 MW Erbil Independent Power Project (IPP) from simple-cycle to combined-cycle technology. The present power plant is equipped with eight 9E GE-gas turbines with a capacity of 1.000 MW and is Iraqi Kurdistan's largest power plant. It will be converted to combined-cycle by additional eight HRSG's and two GE-steam turbines, which will produce an additional extra power of 470 MW with the same gas amount.
